- Test 27 professional baking (trade) recipes and edit all recipes as final for promotion
- Food styling and photography for 27 professional baking (trade) recipes flat rate for project requested (CA Fig Ingredients – Whole, Diced, Paste, E-Diced, Powder and Juice Concentrate – to be provided by CFAB; all other expenses including ingredients and props to be accounted for in proposal)
- Vertical and horizontal images for each recipe to be provided
- Low and high-res image options to be provided
- Unlimited usage rights to CFAB
